#### John 2:14-25

<sup>14</sup> In the temple he found people selling oxen, sheep, and doves, and he also found the money changers sitting there. <sup>15</sup> After making a whip out of cords, he drove everyone out of the temple with their sheep and oxen. He also poured out the money changers' coins and overturned the tables. <sup>16</sup> He told those who were selling doves, "Get these things out of here! Stop turning my Father's house into a marketplace!"

<sup>17</sup> And his disciples remembered that it is written: **Zeal for your house will consume me.** 

- <sup>18</sup> So the Jews replied to him, "What sign will you show us for doing these things?"
- <sup>19</sup> Jesus answered, "Destroy this temple, and I will raise it up in three days."
- <sup>20</sup> Therefore the Jews said, "This temple took forty-six years to build, and will you raise it up in three days?"
- <sup>21</sup> But he was speaking about the temple of his body. <sup>22</sup> So when he was raised from the dead, his disciples remembered that he had said this, and they believed the Scripture and the statement Jesus had made.
- <sup>23</sup> While he was in Jerusalem during the Passover Festival, many believed in his name when they saw the signs he was doing. <sup>24</sup> Jesus, however, would not entrust himself to them, since he knew them all <sup>25</sup> and because he did not need anyone to testify about man; for he himself knew what was in man.
